Teamwork offers the opportunity for you to develop and grow. You learn from others, share your ideas and become motivated to do the best work you can. You also gain leadership and communication skills as well as developing new skills from role models in your team.

The code:

Once you think you have the 4 letters needed to crack the code, rearrange them into the right order to spell out the key word!

Answers:

- 1) Each of the numbers represents a letter of the alphabet. The only number missing is number 20 – the 20th letter of the alphabet is T.
- 2) The flight itinerary shows the route that someone went on. If you draw this out on the map going from Italy to Norway to Poland to Finland to Turkey, this draws the letter M.
- 3) Written in morse code is a sentence reading “the letter you need is A”.
- 4) The letter E has been taken out of all the words in the paragraph about working as a team – the answer is E.

When rearranged, these letters spell **TEAM**.
